**Trade:** The biggest entry at Beaulieu Road since October 2014 and a continued very good trade to go with it. On that day in 2014 when there was also a show, registered colts averaged 34 gns and fillies 74 gns so from then the colt foal average is three times better and the fillies are five times better. I'm not sure we thought that would happen back then! The show certainly helped the trade and the fact that we had eighteen fillies as opposed to one last year was a definite bonus, as these were very keenly contested. All the show results are shown below and very special thanks to our judge Nikki Dibden who had the difficult job of putting so many foals into order. Also thanks to the New Forest Pony Publicity Group and the Livestock Society for organising everything. Fewer stronger and older ponies on show and less customers for these than last month but the trade for donkeys remains very strong.
